Currently, 58.3% of the 1,844 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 16.9%, renter occupied; and 24.8% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 55.4% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.9% are renter occupied; and 11.7% are vacant. In 2010, there were 1,864 housing units in the area - 60.3% owner occupied, 16.0% renter occupied, and 23.7% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is -0.48%. Median home value in the area is \$75,440, compared to a median home value of \$198,891 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 4.03% annually to \$91,905.
